**Objectives of the Programmes**

The aim of this professional industrial safety, occupational health and environmental management programmes are to provide graduates with broad based training required for occupational health, environmental and safety management in the petroleum, power, chemical, transport etc industries and appreciate the regulatory framework for safe environments at both the local and international levels.

**Admission Requirement**

For admission into the programmes, candidates must possess a minimum of Second Class (Upper Division) Honours Bachelor's degree in Science and Engineering. Industry/company workers with 3 years cognate experience who possess a 2<sup>nd</sup> Class (Lower Division) Honours Bachelors degree (with Cumulative Grade Point Average, CGPA of 3.0 or better) will also be admitted.

### **Duration of Programme**

The duration of the programme shall be 12 calendar months of intensive full time study. Industry/company workers can equally attend on modular basis and accumulate credits.

### **Award of degree**

Successful students at the end of the programmes shall receive an M.Sc in Occupational Health and Safety or Environmental Management and Technology of the University of Port Harcourt, Nigeria.

**Available Short Courses / Professional Certifications:** Students will be presented for International and local Environmental and Safety Certifications such as (NREP, USA; NISP and others).

### **Application Fee:**

A non- refundable application fee of **fifteen thousand naira (=N= 15, 000)** in certified bank draft should be made payable to the **Institute of Petroleum Studies, University of Port Harcourt, PMB 2, Choba, Port Harcourt**.
